texture	Explains how things feel when we touch them. In drawing it is the marks made on a surface which represent the way the texture looks.
technique	A particular method of doing an activity.
media	Things you can make an image with like paint, pencil, clay or pastel.
mark	To make a visible impression on a surface such as a line or a dot.
effect	An impression that someone creates by doing something, such as a drawing.

Key facts

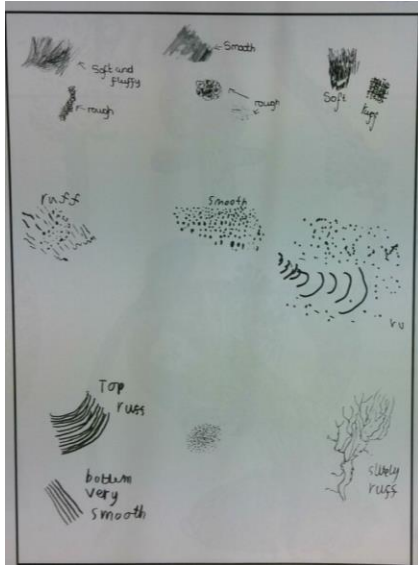
Texture can add interest and definition to a drawing. It can be used to create illusion of difference between one surface and another. E.G fur and skin.

You can use texture to give a drawing variety and interest, to differentiate between one area and another, and to make drawings visually more exciting.

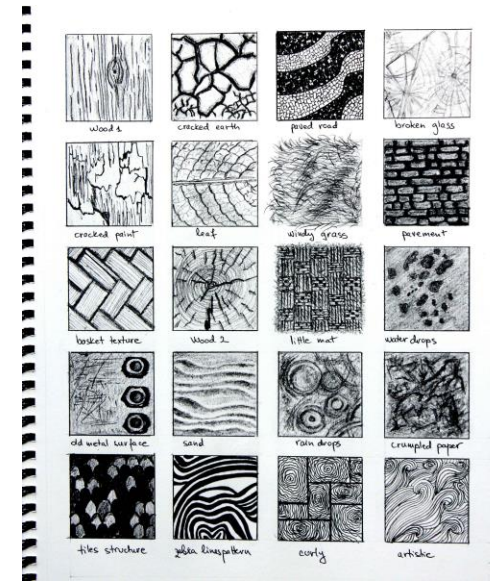
Textural surfaces are experienced through both touch and sight.
