- Working with colleagues, secure high standards of pupil achievement
- Liaise with the SENDCo and other colleagues on KS2 provision to secure positive impact on the progress of all children
- Liaise with colleagues to ensure good transition for pupils
- Provide for the pastoral, educational, social, moral, spiritual and cultural development of each individual child in the class
- Communicate, consult and meet with parents and external agencies, as required, about pupils' academic progress, as well as, where appropriate, their social, emotional and mental health needs
- Provide or contribute to oral and written assessments, reports and references relating to pupils, including for parent consultations and end-of-year pupil reports, and provide curriculum information, as required
- Participate fully in the school's appraisal policy to facilitate the review of teacher performance
- Take an active role in the execution of the School Development Plan

- Keep up to date with current educational research, sharing with colleagues as appropriate, and participate in appropriate professional development
- Contribute to improvements in the quality of teaching and learning across the whole school
- Promote the positive ethos and culture of the school to other staff, governors, parents, children and members of the wider community
- Be proactive in maintaining good order, discipline and high standards of health and safety among pupils and responding promptly and appropriately to safeguarding issues, following school policy
- Set a good example in terms of conduct, dress, punctuality and attendance
- Attend staff meetings as directed by the Headteacher
- Support and promote all school policies and procedures, particularly those relating to child protection, equal opportunities, racial equality, health, safety and security, confidentiality, behaviour and data protection
- Carry out the duties of a Class Teacher as set out in the Teachers' Standards
- Carry out any other professional duties reasonably requested by the Headteacher
