

Mosaic Art

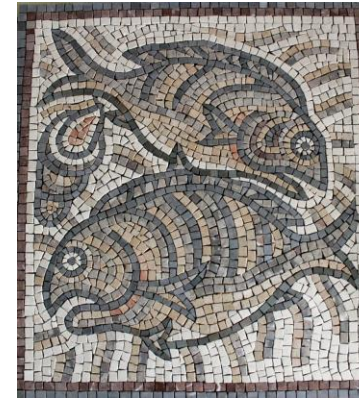
Topic Word	Definition
mosaic	A picture made from lots of small stones or tiles.
tesserae	The coloured square pieces of stone or tile used to create pictures.
grout	The white paste used to fill in the gaps between the tiles.
plaster	The cement-like glue used to stick the tiles down.
frame	The outside edge of the mosaic holding it all in place.
set	When the plaster hardens.
observe	To look closely at other mosaics.
design	Draw your own mosaic.

The floors of Roman buildings were often decorated with mosaics - tiny coloured stones (tesserae).

Many mosaics captured scenes of history and everyday Roman life.

Mosaics included lots of repeated patterns and shapes like squares, triangles and circles.

Mosaics are made by using plaster to stick tiles of different colours in different patterns to create a picture.
