Building Work - funding

Last week it was announced in West Sussex County Times that we were receiving funding for an extension from the South Downs National Park Community Infrastructure Levy. This is part of a longer-term strategy where we are looking to grow the physical space in the current Buzzards classroom so that it matches that of Kestrels and Sparrowhawks.

Unfortunately, the amount awarded is not enough to cover the cost of the work and so we are applying for additional funding in this next round of bids. We have just 3 years from the award of the funding to be able to use it, so fingers crossed we can access more funds, which will allow us to grow the physical classroom space without losing in any other area.

If anyone knows of any companies etc who would like to support a school with improving their building infrastructure and thereby improve the quality of teaching and learning possible, then please do put them in touch with us.

We will be seeking planning permission over the next few months, but I would stress that this will be for something more than we currently have the funds to achieve. We are aiming for the very best possible outcome for improving the school and will tailor our aims, only when we have exhausted all other financial possibilities.
