









# Year 3/4 Islam

Islam	A religion that originated in Mecca in Saudi Arabia.	The prophet Muhammad, who was born in A.D. 570 at Mecca, in Saudi Arabia, is often regarded as the founder of Islam.
Muslim	A person who follows the Islamic faith.	The basic belief of Islam is that there is only one God, whose name in the Arabic language is Allah, and who is the only ruler of the universe
mosque	The place where Muslims go to worship.	<b>The Muslim Holy book is the Holy Qur'an.</b> Muslims believe it is 'the word of God'. Muslim beliefs and practices come from the Qur'an.
prophet	A person who speaks the words of God.	Muslims pray in the direction of Mecca. They kneel on special prayer mats.
pray	To listen and speak to God.	The Holy place of worship is called a Mosque.
Prayer mat	A mat to kneel on while praying.	
		There are 4 pillars of Islam. Shahadah, Salat, Zakat, Sawm and Hajj.
