
Using Google Classroom for online learning at home


You can access your child's Google Classroom by downloading the <u>Google Classroom app</u> or by typing <u>classroom.google.com</u> into a search engine.

ON THE GOOGLE CLASSROOM APP FOR APPLE OR ANDROID.


It is actually easier to use Google Classroom on a browser rather than the app. You will also need to have downloaded Google Drive and Google Docs




- 1. Open the Google Classroom app and log in using your child's username which will be in the format firstname.lastname@bury.school and their password which is a combination of letters and numbers. The capitals are important.
- 2. When they have logged in, they will see the Google Classroom that they are part of in this case it is 'Buzzard Class 2020 2021'. Click on the class name.




3. Click on the work that has been set. The most recent work will show at the top of the stream.



4. Swipe up the arrow at the bottom of the page above 'your work'.




5. Click the title of the document.




6. Edit the document by clicking on the pencil. It will save automatically . When you have finished, click the cross at the top left.
