sacrifice	Christ's offering of himself in the Crucifixion.
salvation	Christians believe it is the deliverance from sin and its consequences brought about by faith.
symbol	A sign or gesture used to represent or stand for something.

The Gospel according to Mark is the second of four New Testament Gospels that recount the life and death of Jesus Christ.

Leonardo da Vinci was an Italian artist born in 1452. He was famous for painting the image of 'The Last Supper'.



Last Supper/Passover Meal

One significant reason Christians give for why Jesus dies is that he dies to save people—to rescue them from their sins and to bring them back


For Christians, the bread and wine have a different symbolism during the Eucharist. The bread symbolises the body of Christ and the wine symbolises the blood of Christ.

The Eucharist is a re-enactment of the Last Supper that Jesus had with his disciples.

Christians believe that Jesus' death was not the end, and that he was resurrected on the Sunday, so Eucharist/Holy Communion is a
