chopping	To chop something into pieces.
dough	A thick, flexible mixture of flour and liquid, used for baking into bread or pastry
grating	To rub food against a grater to cut it into small pieces.
knead	To squeeze and twist dough with hands.
mashing	To reduce food to a soft texture by crushing it.
materials	The matter from which a thing is or can be made.
peeling	Remove the outer covering or skin from fruit or vegetable
shade	Screen from direct sunlight.
shelter	A place giving temporary protection from bad weather or danger.
