worship	Telling God how great he is.

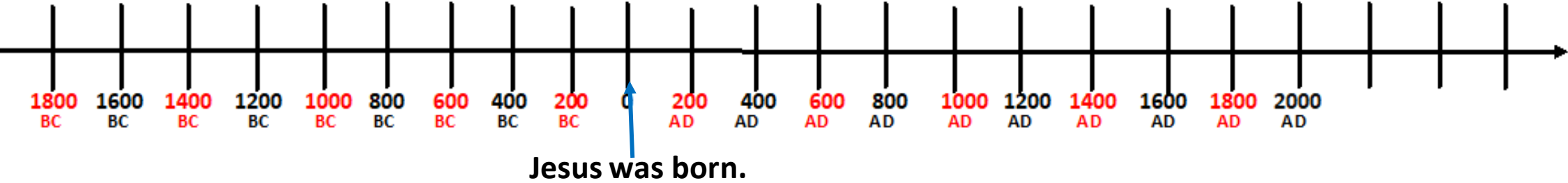
Key facts
