





A very small habitat such as under a rock, under leaves or on a branch. Minibeasts live in microhabitats Animals such as humans, dogs, lions and whales. In general, female mammals give birth to babies rather than laying eggs, and feed their young with milk.

A creature that does not have a spine, for example an insect, a worm, or an octopus.

A creature which has a spine. Mammals, birds, reptiles and fish are vertebrates. Cold blooded animals which have skins covered with small hard plates called scales and lay

eggs.

An area of land that is protected and managed in order to preserve a particular type of habitat and its flora and fauna which are often rare or endangered.
