

A push or a pull against an object or a certain thing.

An upward force that liquid applies to objects.

A type of friction caused by air pushing against a moving object.

A bar where one end is placed under a heavy object so that when you press down on the other end you can move the object.

A pulling force exerted by the Earth (or anything else with a mass). A force that acts between two surfaces or objects that are moving or trying to move across each other.

A device of consisting of a wheel over which a rope or a chain is pulled in order to lift heavy objects. Parts which work together in a machine e.g. pulleys, gears, and levers. The measure of how much matter (or stuff) is inside an object.
